Upcoming Important Dates

- October 10 - Market Turkey Orders/money due, Fair Office, NO LATER than 4:00 p.m.
- October 16 – (Tentative) Meeting for all students and parents who plan to show at a Major livestock Show.
 - o Will have forms to fill out, computers to pay for entry fees on RevTrak, and a notary to notarize all entry forms.
- October 19 – County Steer Validation & Tag-in, 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.
- October 23 – Major Lamb and Goat Validation at the County Fairgrounds, 5:00-6:30 p.m.
- October 26 – Commercial Heifer/Breeding Beef Validation & Tag-in, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon.
 - o ALL NON-REGISTERED HEIFERS, COWS AND BULLS MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE FAIRGROUNDS FOR VALIDATION
 - o APPROVED REGISTERED BREED CLASSIFICATION: Registered breeding heifers, cows and bulls with papers for an Approved Registered Breed do not have to come to the fairgrounds for validation. However, the exhibitor must come to the fairgrounds with the original registered papers showing that the heifer, cow or bull is registered in the exhibitor's name. One (1) copy of the registration papers must be given to the Chairperson. The Tattoo or firebrand must match the registered papers or the animal will be disqualified. This information will be verified at check-in.
 - o A.B.C. & A.O.B. CLASSIFICATION: Exhibitors of Non-registered and Papers Pending breeding heifers, cows and bulls must bring their completed validation/tag-in form and their cattle to the fairgrounds for nose-printing and classification. These forms will be available at the Fair Office.
- October 29 – Major Heifer Validation at the County Fairgrounds, 4:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
